i. Background for Nomination

Induction into the BCCM Honour Roll provides recognition of the significant contributions that an individual has made over a considerable time in support of the co-operative and mutual form of enterprise. It is important that your nominee has a track record of accomplishments that have benefited the CME sector.

Individually and collectively, they have enhanced and advanced co-operative and mutual enterprises, empowered people through their association with CMEs, and contributed to the broader acceptance of the CME model.

i We are looking for a short summary of the nominee’s service to the sector to read out at the industry dinner. The summary should describe the nominee’s service, highlights of their service, and any significant achievements.

iii. Summary of Service

Nominating organisations are asked to provide a short (maximum 2–pages) summary of service of the nominee. Please provide information, **not to exceed 2 typed pages**, that identifies the nominee’s major contributions and activities relating any of the following criteria:

1. Demonstrated personal commitment and responsibility, innovation, leadership and vision beyond the professional competence and requirements of the position for which they were employed to serve within the CME sector.
2. Achieved identifiable and lasting changes to improve and promote CMEs.
3. Inspired and persuaded others to act to advance the CME sector.
4. Recognised for work relating to co-operatives and mutuals at one or more of the following levels – local, regional, national or international.

iv. Statements of Endorsement

Please include no more than three statements of endorsement for the nominee. These should take the form of quotes that can be read out at the dinner.

v. Photos

Please provide 8–10 high resolution photos relating to the nominee’s service. Photos can be of the nominee or can simply correspond to their service. There should be at least one “bio style” photo of the nominee. These photos will help us compile a short video that will screen at the industry dinner. You can also provide 1–2 short videos of no more than 00:20 seconds in length each.

vi. Nominator(s)

If the nominee is selected for induction to the BCCM Honour Roll, the nominator will be responsible for the travel and logistics related to the individual’s recognition, in collaboration with BCCM.

viii. Qualities of a BCCM Honour Roll 2023 recipient

Conviction	A fixed or strong belief in co-operative and mutual principles
Dedication	Personal commitment and devotion to promoting successful co-operative and mutual enterprises
Innovation	The ability to open a new line of thinking, or doing business in new ways
Loyalty	The feeling of allegiance to the mission and values of the CME sector
Selfless	Acting with less concern for the self than for a co-operative or mutual, or the CME sector as a whole
Vision	The ability to see and articulate the optimal future of a co-operative or mutual business or the CME sector as a whole
